Notice to Competitors

The draw for Round 1 will be in handicap order (lowest to highest). Draw for Round 2 will be in gross score, order highest to lowest. Handicaps will be checked on Wednesday August 9th for round 1 draw and will be checked again on Sunday, August 13th at 7 pm. This handicap will be used for both rounds.

We encourage you to join the gallery at the 18th green to cheer on the final groups on Thursday 17th

Format: 36 Hole Stroke Play, Club Champion trophy for Low Gross and trophy for Low Net.

Ground Under Repair:

All bare patches **on the fairways only** are deemed ground under repair. Nearest point of relief no closer to the hole for swing & stance only. Ball must be dropped not placed.

Immovable Obstruction:

All protective screens and all gravel, paved, in bounds, are immovable obstructions. Nearest point of relief for stance and swing only. Ball must be dropped not placed. There is a drop area on #16 by the willow tree for relief from the gravel and pump house.

Exceptions: 1) the fence defining the driving range is a boundary fence and no relief is permitted.
2) the wooden fence protecting the pond in front of the #18 tee box is an integral part of the course and no relief is permitted.

Lateral Hazards – Red Stakes:

All ponds are lateral water hazards. There **is a drop area behind and to the left of #11 green**. It is to be used only if it does not put the ball closer to the hole than the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard. The two drop areas behind #2 green are only to be used if the ball entered the hazard between the drop areas. Use the closest drop area. For a ball that entered the hazard outside the drop areas, the normal relief options are available.

Out of Bounds:

All areas marked by white stakes and inside the fence of the driving range. The white stakes between holes #3 and #4 define out of bounds only when playing hole number #3. All perimeter chip paths are out of bounds.

Embedded Ball Rule:

The embedded ball rule is to be applied "through the green".

Low Gross and Low Net ties will be decided by an 18 hole playoff to be arranged in discussion with tournament chair. Other ties will be determined by matching scorecards (count back method) as recommended by Golf Canada.

If in doubt about a rule, play a second ball, score both balls, indicate which ball you prefer to use and check with Rules Committee before signing your card.
