Half the field will be on **President's Team. Please wear BLUE.**
Matches will be arranged by handicap. Individual and Team prizes.

Entry fee: \$10 per person. Cash or cheque only, to be collected at first tee.

- Higher handicap gets strokes off lower handicap opponent.
- Women play from Red tees. Men play from Blue tees.
- On first tee, lowest handicap tees off first, and then you play "honours" after that.
- RCGA Rules apply. The Local Rule (for out-of-bounds or lost ball) is not in effect.
- No "gimmes" but opponent may concede the hole at anytime.
- If your match is tied after the 18th hole, it will remain as a tie.
- You don't have to walk in after the match is over...have fun and finish the game.

Scorecards: One official score card per pair. Both players sign the card, which will be collected at 18th green.

Disputes: If you encounter a rules situation, you must resolve it there and then. If you cannot agree, the other two players in your group will decide.

No-shows: In case of advanced cancellations, the tournament committee will try to find a replacement. If a player fails to show up on tournament day, the player in attendance wins the match.

Captain vs President Match Play

One-on-one match play:

- Each hole is won by the lowest Net score; a player will win, lose or tie each hole.
- Within each pairing, the lower handicap player will “give strokes” to the higher handicap player. (Men’s handicap holes are at the top of the card; Women’s handicap holes are at bottom.)
- On first tee, the lower handicap tees off first; then you play “honours” after that.
- You may concede the hole at anytime and may “give” your opponent a putt for the win or a tie.
- The match is over when one player leads by more holes than are left to play. If you’re tied at 18, your match will be recorded as a tie.
- You don’t have to walk in after the match is over...have fun and finish the game.

Playing out of turn:

- In Match Play, whoever is “away” plays next. While there is no penalty for playing out of turn, the opponent does have the option to require the stroke be cancelled and replayed at the proper time.
- However, to maintain pace of play, it’s ok to invite your opponent to “go ahead if you’re ready”, without consequence.

Scoring:

- Each player keeps their own card, and should confirm the scores with their opponent at the end of each hole.
- Turn in one official card, signed by both players, after the 18th hole.
- On the card, please indicate clearly which player won the match, and at which hole the match ended.

General:

- Winter Rules Preferred Lies: mark, lift, clean and place within 6 inches.
- In case of abnormal course conditions, come to agreement with your opponent as to where it is reasonable to take a drop.
- The Local Rule (for out-of-bounds or lost ball) is not in effect.
- **Pace of play** matters...if you’re falling behind and the hole has been won or tied, pick up and move on.
- **Disputes:** If you encounter a rules situation, you must resolve it there and then. If you cannot agree, the other two players in your group will decide.
